Vote-by-Mail Ballots in Mail; Voting Begins

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that vote-by-mail voting has begun for the Special General Election. Voters can return their completed ballot by mail, drop it off at the Elections Office, or return to any polling location on Election Day, January 4, 2011.

The Governor called a special general election to be held January 4, 2011 to fill the vacancy in Senate District 1 (SD1) left by the passing of Senator Dave Cox. This election will encompass approximately one-third of the County. Please refer to the <u>SD1</u> map on the Elections website for the district boundaries in Sacramento County.
