## Last Day to Register for the January 4 Special General Election

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine reminds anyone interested in voting in the upcoming Special General Election they have until Monday, December 20, 2010 to register. "We urge individuals who are not currently registered to do so before the deadline," says LaVine.

The Governor called a special general election to be held January 4, 2011 to fill the vacancy in Senate District 1 (SD1) left by the passing of Senator Dave Cox.
