- Department of Neighborhood Services, 5229-B Hazel Avenue, Fair Oaks 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. M - Th
- Rancho Cordova City Hall, 2729 Prospect Park Dr., Rancho Cordova 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. T - Th (office closed on Dec. 27)
- Voter Registration and Elections, 7000 65th Street, Sacramento, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, and until 8 p.m. on Election Day (office closed on December 31 but a drop-box is located outside the building), or
- Any polling place in Sacramento County on Election Day

The deadline to return vote-by-mail ballots is 8 p.m. on Election Day. Ballots received after 8 p.m. will not be counted. Also remember to sign your return ballot envelope or it will not be counted.

December 28, 2010 is the last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot be mailed to you.
