Voters Encouraged to Confirm Registration Status Online

In a statement issued by the Election Assistance Commission (EAC) Chairperson Rosemary Rodriguez, all voters are reminded to take the necessary steps now to ensure they are ready to participate in the November 4, 2008 General Election.

“People who have registered for the first time should confirm that they provided all the required information and are indeed registered,” says Rodriguez. Many voters move between elections and fail to update their addresses with the local registrar which can create problems on Election Day.

The last day to register to vote for the November General Election is October 20, 2008. Registration cards are available at post offices, libraries or calling our office at (916) 875-6451.

“We encourage all voters in Sacramento County to check our website to confirm that they are registered at their correct address,” says Sacramento County Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine.
