Registrar of Voters Election Update

Sacramento County Offers Vote-by-Mail Drop-off Sites for the Special Statewide Election

Voters who do not want to drop their ballots in the mail may choose to drop it off at any of seven locations throughout Sacramento County.

Sacramento County's downtown administration center and designated city clerk offices will serve as Vote-by-Mail ballot drop-off sites beginning Monday, May 11 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The service will be available through Friday, May 15, 2009.

"We understand that it may be more convenient for some voters to drop off their ballot rather than sending it through the mail," says Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine. "We have partnered with our Clerk of the Board and local city clerks to provide additional drop-off locations within the community that may be closer to home or work for voters."

Ballot boxes will be stationed at the County administration building (Clerk of the Board office on the 2nd floor) and at the front counters of designated city clerk offices. For a list of drop-off locations, addresses, and hours, go to the Elections web site at www.elections.saccounty.net.
