#### **BALLOT COUNTING COMPLETED**

#### **Registrar Certifies Statewide Special Election**

Sacramento County Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that ballot counting for the May 19, 2009 Statewide Special Election has been completed and official results posted online. By law, counties have 28 days following an election to process all of the remaining ballots.

“The official turnout for Sacramento County in the Statewide Special Election was 31.1 percent,” said LaVine. Of the 210,469 votes cast at the Statewide Special Election, 63.7 percent were cast by vote-by-mail voters, while 36.3 percent were cast at a polling place.
