On Thursday, Governor Schwarzenegger issued a proclamation calling for a Special Election in the 10th Congressional District which encompasses Sacramento, Contra Costa, Alameda and Solano Counties. The Primary Election will be held on September 1, 2009.

“Due to the appointment of Ellen O. Tauscher by President Obama as the Undersecretary of State for Arms Control and International Security, it has left a vacancy that needs to be filled in the 10th Congressional District” Says Jill LaVine, Sacramento County Registrar of Voters.

The nomination period is currently open and nomination documents are available at the Voter Registration and Elections Office at 7000 65th Street, Sacramento, California. The term of office for United States Representative is 2 years.

The Sacramento County elections office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekdays (excluding county holidays). Documents must be filed not later than 5:00 p.m. on July 20, 2009.
