Get Rid of Your Junk Cars for Free!

Sacramento County and City of West Sacramento Partner to Preempt Blight

Sacramento, Calif. – On September 9 through September 12, Sacramento County and the City of West Sacramento, in partnership with Pick-n-Pull Auto Dismantlers, are offering free pick up of unwanted or abandoned vehicles at no charge in the unincorporated area of Sacramento County and the City of West Sacramento.

“Not only is there no charge or hassle for the vehicle owners, this event will provide an easy way for the vehicle owners to remove code violations from their property. Additional benefit for County Code Enforcement which will earn money for every car that is picked up. This is a win-win for all community residents.”

This applies to any kind of vehicle up to and including 18 feet long:

- If residents owe fines and cannot pay
- Paperwork cannot be located (Note – VIN numbers will be checked)
- The vehicle is not running

County Residents simply call the Amnesty Hot-Line -1-866-520-9749 - at any time to schedule a pick up date. The vehicles will be picked up at no charge for four days, from September 9 through September 12. (Applies to residents in unincorporated County only)

West Sacramento Residents can call or drop vehicles off during the four days at 900 South River Road, West Sacramento from 9:00am to 3:00 pm and get a \$50.00 gift certificate for Pick-N-Pull as a reward!
