Sacramento County to continue FY 09-10 Budget Deliberations

The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors will continue its budget deliberations for Fiscal Year 2009-10 on Tuesday September 22 at 2:15 p.m.

With the continuing impacts of the recession, including major reductions in sales and property tax revenues, and the forced cuts because of the State's budget challenges, the County has already reduced the size of its labor force and scope of operations. New sales tax figures, reported from April through June, have put an additional \$4 million burden on the County and must be dealt with before the budget can be finalized.

Discussions continue with the County's labor organizations in an effort to reach possible cost reductions to avoid the need for more layoffs. Managers, unrepresented workers, and some represented bargaining units already participate in payroll concessions.

The Board of Supervisors' budget is anticipated to become final with the formal adoption of the \$4.2 billion spending plan on September 29.
