PROPOSITION 8 RULING – SAME-SEX MARRIAGE LICENSES

Sacramento, Calif. – Today, Judge Vaughn R. Walker ruled on the stay of the entry of judgment in the Same-Sex Marriage case entitled *Perry v. Schwarzenegger*. The court has denied the request and directed the clerk to enter the judgment to cease enforcement of Proposition 8. However, that judgment is stayed until August 18, 2010, at 5 p.m. It should be noted that there are additional legal avenues for appeals with the Appellate Court.

County Clerk/Recorder Craig Kramer said that “we will comply with the [Order of the Court](#) and will not issue any licenses to same-sex couples until after 5 p.m. on August 18, 2010, or until receipt of any other direction from the courts.”

Hours of operation may be extended on August 18, 2010, if this office is allowed to issue same-sex marriage licenses and such changes will be communicated.
